

CALCULATING WINNER: The tournament chairperson and/or prize chairperson will assist you in selecting winners as the % of the winning field may vary. Send a list of winners to the webmaster, the prize chairman, and publicity chairman. A photo of the scoring sheets can be sent to the prize chairman to facilitate issuing prize certificates. GCGA Prize Certificates can be used at any member club and expire each year on September 30. Remind the pro to mail in certificates to the treasurer by Oct. 31.

AWARDING OF PRIZES WITH TIES: GROSS takes precedence over NET with the exception of the winner who is LOW NET of the field or flight. TIES IN REGULAR TOURNAMENTS – add places and award equal certificates.

TIES IN TOURNAMENTS WITH TRAVELING TROPHIES: Gross – match score cards from the back nine, last six holes, last three holes, or the 18th hole. Net – match scores for the back nine less ½ handicap, last six holes less 1/3 handicap, etc. Fractions less than ½ are disregarded; fractions of ½ or more count as a full stroke. If this does not produce a winner, lot shall determine the winners.

AFTER LUNCH: Meet with the treasurer or her designee and turn in checks, including players that cancelled after pairings were made. Indicate on outside of envelope the Tournament name, number of entries and amount enclosed. Indicate the # of players paying for food only (if they're using their own cart at home course) and # of players paying for food and cart. Note: At the past president's tournament, past presidents only pay for their cart as the meal is complementary. A check will be written to the pro and the club for food service, carts, and gratuities. Miscellaneous Expenses – Obtain approval from the treasurer for any additional expenses for your tournament and submit receipts for reimbursement.
